How To Uncover All Sins:

1. Ask God to reveal the true condition of your heart. (Psalm 139:23-24)
2. Confess to God what sins you are hiding, and why. (Psalm 32:5, 9)
3. Commit to corresponding characteristics or principles of Christ or a fruit of the Holy Spirit that does battle with the sins you are hiding.
(cf. Romans 13:14; Galatians 5:22-23)
4. Commit to being "naked" before others in a way that invites accountability or opportunity to share about the Gospel.
(cf., James 5:16)
