

Risk of illness? Experiencing Symptoms?

- If you are in a “high risk category” for contracting COVID-19, we encourage you to stay at home and engage via our livestream.
- If you or a member of your family has been exposed to someone with COVID-19 within the last 2 weeks or developed any COVID-19 symptoms, we ask you to remain home.

Registration information

- Registration for that week’s services will be open from Monday – Saturday at 5 p.m.
- Please register yourself and anyone coming with you; we cap each service at 100 people in order to maintain social distancing guidelines in the auditorium.

Arriving at the EMHS building

- As you approach the building, please keep at least 6 feet of distance between you (your family) and others.
- If you need the restroom, please use the side door to go directly there and outside again before entering the lobby.
- Please keep your children with you at all times.
- A greeter will welcome you into the lobby in a staggered entry, and lead you to one side of the auditorium, where you will be taken to a row of seats.

During your time in the building

- In accordance with Governor Northam’s Executive Order, a mask covering the mouth and nose is to be worn by everyone age five and older while in the building. We also encourage, based on CDC recommendations, that children between ages two and four wear a mask to the extent possible. We will have a limited number of masks available at the door.
- Once you are at your seat, please try to remain there for the duration of the service.
- Please keep your children with you at all times, and ensure that all members of your family maintain social distancing.

Service information

- Our services will last approximately 45 minutes.
- There will be no greeting time during the service and no passing of offering baskets. We encourage you to continue giving faithfully online, via text-to-give, or in the baskets placed at the auditorium entrances and exit.
- Aletheia Jr.: We will provide limited childcare for ages 1-3 as soon as it is feasible. We provide a bag of activities and a snack for older children and encourage them to participate in the service.
- There will be no food or coffee served.
- We will have pre-packaged wafers and juice to use during communion available on the front table in the lobby. Please pick one up as you enter—we will celebrate communion together at the end of the service.

As you leave the building

- We will exit through the side middle doors of the auditorium. Please maintain social distancing from others as you make your way out.
- Once you have exited the building, please make your way to your vehicle while practicing social distancing measures.
