

## **Nursery Guidelines during COVID**

All Saints Anglican Church

- Nursery staff are not to serve with any of the following symptoms: fever over 100.4, cough, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, or sinus congestion not related to allergies.
- Nursery staff should screen one another upon arrival: take temperatures and confirm non-exposure.
  - Has anyone in your home been exposed to COVID in the past two weeks?
  - Is anyone in your home currently exhibiting symptoms of COVID (see above)?
- Nursery staff must always wear a mask and wash hands often with soap and water.
- When using plastic gloves, nursery staff should only use one set per respective task, otherwise wash hands.
- Nursery staff will clean and disinfect toys and frequently touched surfaces, especially in between services.
- Nursery staff will wear smocks or aprons so as to be able to change out when necessary.
- Hand towels made available for cleaning
- Nursery staff will practice social distance as much as feasible.
- Nursery staff will ask parents to confirm a short questionnaire:
  - Has anyone in your home been exposed to COVID in the past two weeks?
  - Is anyone in your home currently exhibiting symptoms of COVID (see above)?
- Only food and drink provided by the parents will be given to children at this time. Nursery staff will follow the direction of the parents.
- As weather allows, the windows in the Nursery will be cracked to allow for better air circulation.
- Records of attendance will be kept for each Sunday—Nursery staff and children. Contact information will be obtained by all parents of children.
- Ensure that hand sanitizer is made available.
