Here we pause in silence to meditate upon our sin and need for forgiveness.







First Scripture Lesson

And you, take up a lamentation for the princes of Israel, ² and say:

What was your mother? A lioness! Among lions she crouched; in the midst of young lions she reared her cubs.

- And she brought up one of her cubs; he became a young lion, and he learned to catch prey; he devoured men.
- ⁴ The nations heard about him; he was caught in their pit, and they brought him with hooks to the land of Egypt.
- When she saw that she waited in vain, that her hope was lost, she took another of her cubs and made him a young lion.
- ⁶ He prowled among the lions; he became a young lion, and he learned to catch prey; he devoured men,
- ⁷ and seized their widows. He laid waste their cities, and the land was appalled and all who were in it at the sound of his roaring.
- Then the nations set against him from provinces on every side; they spread their net over him; he was taken in their pit.

- With hooks they put him in a cage and brought him to the king of Babylon; they brought him into custody, that his voice should no more be heard on the mountains of Israel.
- Your mother was like a vine in a vineyard planted by the water, fruitful and full of branches by reason of abundant water.
- Its strong stems became rulers' scepters; it towered aloft among the thick boughs; it was seen in its height with the mass of its branches.
- But the vine was plucked up in fury, cast down to the ground; the east wind dried up its fruit; they were stripped off and withered. As for its strong stem, fire consumed it.
- Now it is planted in the wilderness, in a dry and thirsty land.
- And fire has gone out from the stem of its shoots,
 has consumed its fruit,
 so that there remains in it no strong stem,
 no scepter for ruling.

Second Scripture Lesson

¹³ Then the sixth angel blew his trumpet, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar before God, 14 saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates." 15 So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour, the day, the month, and the year, were released to kill a third of mankind. 16 The number of mounted troops was twice ten thousand times ten thousand; I heard their number. ¹⁷ And this is how I saw the horses in my vision and those who rode them: they wore breastplates the color of fire and of sapphire and of sulfur, and the heads of the horses were like lions' heads, and fire and smoke and sulfur came out of their mouths. ¹⁸ By these three plagues a third of mankind was killed, by the fire and smoke and sulfur coming out of their mouths. ¹⁹ For the power of the horses is in their mouths and in their tails, for their tails are like serpents with heads, and by means of them they wound.

²⁰The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands nor give up worshiping demons and idols of gold and silver and bronze and stone and wood, which cannot see or hear or walk, ²¹ nor did they repent of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.
