Confession of Sin
O Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, we have sinned and done wrong and acted wickedly and rebelled, turning aside from your commandments and rules. To you, O Lord, belongs righteousness, but to us open shame because we have sinned against you. First Scripture Lesson

The vision of Obadiah.

Thus says the Lord GOD concerning Edom:

We have heard a report from the LORD, and a messenger has been sent among the nations:

"Rise up! Let us rise against her for battle!"

- Behold, I will make you small among the nations; you shall be utterly despised.
- The pride of your heart has deceived you, you who live in the clefts of the rock, in your lofty dwelling, who say in your heart,

"Who will bring me down to the ground?"

- Though you soar aloft like the eagle, though your nest is set among the stars, from there I will bring you down, declares the LORD.
- If thieves came to you, if plunderers came by night how you have been destroyed! would they not steal only enough for themselves?

If grape gatherers came to you, would they not leave gleanings?

- 6 How Esau has been pillaged, his treasures sought out!
- All your allies have driven you to your border; those at peace with you have deceived you; they have prevailed against you;

those who eat your bread3 have set a trap beneath you—

you have4 no understanding.

- Will I not on that day, declares the LORD, destroy the wise men out of Edom, and understanding out of Mount Esau?
- 9 And your mighty men shall be dismayed, O Teman, so that every man from Mount Esau will be

cut off by slaughter.

Because of the violence done to your brother Jacob, shame shall cover you,

and you shall be cut off forever.

- On the day that you stood aloof,
 on the day that strangers carried off his wealth
 and foreigners entered his gates
 and cast lots for Jerusalem,
 you were like one of them.
- But do not gloat over the day of your brother in the day of his misfortune; do not rejoice over the people of Judah in the day of their ruin; do not boast in the day of distress.
- Do not enter the gate of my people in the day of their calamity; do not gloat over his disaster in the day of his calamity; do not loot his wealth in the day of his calamity.
- Do not stand at the crossroads to cut off his fugitives; do not hand over his survivors in the day of distress.
- For the day of the LORD is near upon all the nations.

As you have done, it shall be done to you; your deeds shall return on your own head.

- For as you have drunk on my holy mountain, so all the nations shall drink continually; they shall drink and swallow, and shall be as though they had never been.
- ¹⁷ But in Mount Zion there shall be those who escape,

and it shall be holy,

and the house of Jacob shall possess their own possessions.

The house of Jacob shall be a fire, and the house of Joseph a flame, and the house of Esau stubble; they shall burn them and consume them, and there shall be no survivor for the house of Esau,

for the LORD has spoken.

Those of the Negeb shall possess Mount Esau, and those of the Shephelah shall possess the land of the Philistines;

they shall possess the land of Ephraim and the land of Samaria,

Second Scripture Lesson

²⁴ He put another parable before them, saying, "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a man who sowed good seed in his field, 25 but while his men were sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat and went away. ²⁶ So when the plants came up and bore grain, then the weeds appeared also. ²⁷ And the servants of the master of the house came and said to him, 'Master, did you not sow good seed in your field? How then does it have weeds?' 28 He said to them, 'An enemy has done this.' So the servants said to him, 'Then do you want us to go and gather them?' 29 But he said, 'No, lest in gathering the weeds you root up the wheat along with them. ³⁰ Let both grow together until the harvest, and at harvest time I will tell the reapers, "Gather the weeds first and bind them in bundles to be burned, but gather the wheat into my barn.""

³¹ He put another parable before them, saying, "The kingdom of heaven is like a grain of mustard seed that a man took and sowed in his field. ³² It is the smallest of all seeds, but when it has grown it is larger than all the garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and make nests in its branches."

³³ He told them another parable. "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven that a woman took and hid in three measures of flour, till it was all leavened."

³⁴ All these things Jesus said to the crowds in parables; indeed, he said nothing to them without a parable. ³⁵ This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet:

"I will open my mouth in parables;
I will utter what has been hidden since
the foundation of the world."

³⁶Then he left the crowds and went into the house. And his disciples came to him, saying, "Explain to us the parable of the weeds of the field." ³⁷ He answered, "The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man. 38 The field is the world, and the good seed is the sons of the kingdom. The weeds are the sons of the evil one, 39 and the enemy who sowed them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are angels. 40 Just as the weeds are gathered and burned with fire, so will it be at the end of the age. 41 The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will gather out of his kingdom all causes of sin and all law-breakers, ⁴² and throw them into the fiery furnace. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. ⁴³ Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears, let him hear.


