

Dear Alumni and Friends of CPC New Haven and Mission Anabaino,

We at Christ Presbyterian Church New Haven and Mission Anabaino pray you are well and with the anticipation of a very Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!

Speaking of, there is often much ado about the "real" meaning of Christmas. From a historical perspective, the great irony is that Christmas (on December 25th as associated with Christ's date of birth) was a 4th century attempt to Christianize pagan solstice celebrations. Perhaps the jury is still out as to whether or not the whole program has been a success, or that the sum effect has been to paganize Christianity -- the debate continues. But one thing is for sure, to the extent that we remember Christ's incarnation this season, we can all agree that the real meaning of Christ's birth is "Immanuel, God with us," wherein "God and sinner reconciled" (in the words of the Christmas hymn *Hark the Herald Angels Sing*).

And yet this begs the question: How then during Christ's ascension ministry today is Christ STILL with us unto salvation? The clear answer according to scripture is the real, if mediated, presence of Christ in and through the local church (to the degree that this church is carefully built upon the foundation of the apostles with Christ as the cornerstone c.f. Eph 1:22-23, 2:19-22).

Think about it, if this is true, *really true*, then to participate in the birth of a new church in an unreached place is to participate in "Christmas" and the "re-birth" of Christ (mediated) all over again! This mystery is great indeed, how it is that the church becomes the very body of Christ in the midst of us (Eph 1:22). But it is real, even as we see how the church is described as the very epi-center of the coming of the kingdom of God in Matthew 16.


Stated practically, there is no greater evangelistic strategy such as to impact not only this life, but the life that is to come, than to participate in the birth of a new church. It's a place where people are evangelized from their infancy to their death, and it is made accessible both socially and geographically in so far as Christ is in the midst of us by means of the local Christ centered church. - MA is uniquely gifted and experienced at cultivating scratch plants in frontier regions.

WHAT WE NEED
