

WHAT IS THE PLAN?

The idea is to arrive at Interstate Park at 830AM. Complete what ever rental documents that need completing load into your canoe/Kayak and shove off by 9AM. There is an island approximately 5.5 miles down stream that served as a great spot for lunch in the past. From there you can travel another 1.5 miles to the Osceola boat landing. If your looking for more of a challenge, you can continue down the St. Croix another 10 miles past Osceola to William O'Brian State Park.

If you are interested, you can make arrangements for rental on your own but please let Sean Staum know if you are coming. We want to keep a list so that nobody is **Left Behind!**

ANNUAL BEACON ON THE CROIX

COST

If you do not already have an annual vehicle pass for Interstate park you will need to purchase a daily pass for \$7. If you make reservations online the cost is \$35.50 for the canoe (2 paddles & 2 PFD's) and \$25.50 for the kayak (1 paddle and 1PFD). Additional PFD's are \$3.50. Walk up rentals are available but they are an additional \$10. There is a shuttle service to bring you back to Interstate Park included in the cost.



FOOD

You will want to pack a lunch and plenty of beverages as there are no "Roach Coaches" around to provide refreshments.



EQUIPMENT NEEDED

Hat, Sunscreen, Ziplock baggie (for your phone), MacGyver knife and Duct Tape for survival needs.

ALREADY HAVE A CANOE?

Drop it off at interstate (you will still need to purchase a daily pass if you already do not have an annual pass) and then drive down to the Osceola or William O'Brian park to park your vehicle (you'll need a ride back to interstate though).

You can also just leave your vehicle at Interstate and plan for the shuttle service to bring you back to your vehicle. This service is \$20 and they will not transport your canoe/kayak, you'll need to return.
