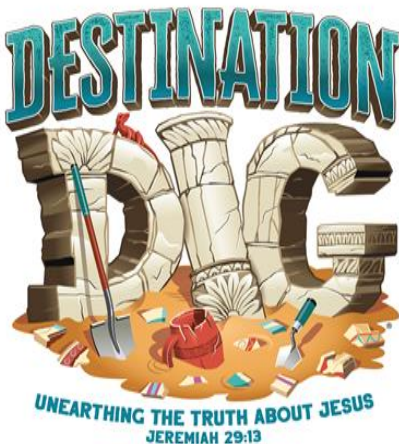
Happening this week:
