We join many of you as you celebrate God's goodness at the various milestones of your children and grandchildren's lives. Kaelee will be a freshman in the Fall at MidAmerica Nazarene University.

Let's remember to pray for and encourage our Bethel graduates as they transition from High School to the next season of their lives. These are crucial days for them in many ways, especially in the development and practice of their walk with God.

Here are a few updates and concerns for prayer from my side of the desk:

Bethel Committees It is that time of year when we are preparing for our annual business meeting in July. The Nominating Committee has sent invitations to several to consider serving as elder, deacon and other positions. These are important leadership roles – please pray for those who are considering whether to serve or not. The Finance Committee is beginning the process of drawing up a budget for 2021-22 to present to the church family. Also, our Missions Committee will be meeting to review our missions budget and the needs of our 14 missionaries and 3 ministries that Bethel partners with.

Please pray for them as they finish up some classwork, travel to spend time with family and prepare to move. They plan to be at Bethel the weekend of June 26-27 to connect with the Youth and Worship teams and join us for services.

Suffering After 7 months and 16 sermons in 1Peter, we plan to begin chapter 4 this coming Sunday. I have been consistently impressed with the relevance of God's word. I encourage you to find 30 minutes before Sunday and read the entire 5 chapters. Mark or note terms or concepts that are repeated. Select a 2-3 verse section that grabs you and commit it to memory. Note the multiple times suffering, testing and trials are mentioned. My favorite mind-boggling concept to chew on so far is the blessedness of suffering like Jesus did – unjustly while entrusting himself to his Father who judges justly.
