(4) What did Jesus mean by the words “spirit and truth” when he spoke of worship?

(5) Describe your reaction to the worship at Bridgeway. What was your impression when you first started attending? Do you see a healthy convergence here between head and heart, between mind and spirit, between beliefs and feeling? If not, why not?
