Genesis 1:1

1. What were some of the things we learned that God was doing before the foundation of the world? Why are these things significant and how do they apply to us?
2. What is unique about the word “created” in Gen. 1:1? What is the difference between God creating and people creating?
3. What do we learn about God from His creating the heavens, with all their stars, planets, comets, etc., and the earth with its clear design from the microscopic level to the laws of science, etc? As you consider this question, read Job 37-41. What are we supposed to learn from what God created? How should it affect the way we live, how we deal with problems, and our perspective of the world?
4. Henry Morris said that Gen. 1:1 is the most important verse in all the Bible. Why? He said it refutes atheism, pantheism, polytheism, materialism, dualism, humanism, and evolutionism. How so?
