



## Day 2

- A. Many times the author will give a reason why he was moved to write the book, in the book itself. Look through the letter again and then record the reason that Jude wrote this book.
- B. Review verse 4 and determine what was happening in the churches that prompted Jude to feel it was necessary to write as he did?
- C. Look up the following verses to discover how serious the problem was that Jude was writing about: Gal 2:4; Eph. 4:13-15; 2 Tim. 3:1-6; 2 Peter 2:1-6. Briefly record what you find.

**Eager Beaver:** Please look up the whole chapter of 2 Peter 2, then make a comprehensive list of all the things that are characteristics of ungodly men, who have crept into our churches. This would include your findings from #C, Day 1. Record your answers on the chart provided entitled "Characteristics of Ungodly Men).

### Day 3

- A. Look through the text to find those who are the recipients of this letter and mark them in some distinctive way. Either use a certain color or a certain way of marking them, on your Observation Worksheet. Also record what you learn on the chart provided, entitled "The Godly and the Ungodly in the book of Jude".
- B. From marking the recipients, make a list of all you learn about them, such as: how Jude refers to them, and what kind of promises God has made to them. Record this information on your chart also.

### Day 4

- A. There is another group of people causing problems in the church that Jude addresses. These type of people are still causing problems in the church today. Since it was important for Jude's hearers to be able to recognize them in our churches. Go through your Observation Worksheet and mark them in a distinctive way.
- B. Now make a list of these certain ungodly persons including information like: their description, the coming judgment on them and phrases that do contrasts and comparisons of these men and other things. Record this information in the space provided on the chart entitled "The Godly and the Ungodly in the book of Jude".
- C. Are there any characteristics of the ungodly that describe you? Which ones? Confess those to the Lord who forgives.
- D. Pick 1 or 2 verses that encapsulates the message of the book of Jude.

## Day 5

Summarizing Theme (a theme is one unit of thought)

- A. Briefly summarize paragraph 1, verses 1 and 2
  
- B. Briefly summarize paragraph 2, verses 3 and 4
  
- C. Briefly summarize paragraph 3, verses 5 through 7
  
- D. Briefly summarize paragraph 4, verses 8 through 16
  
- E. Briefly summarize paragraph 5, verses 17 through 23
  
- F. Briefly summarize paragraph 6, verses 24 and 25
  
- G. Come up with one sentence that summarizes and reflects the 6 themes of the book of Jude.

- H. Last but not least, read through Jude one more time paying close attention to the information you have gleaned so far and compose a Title for this book. The title should be very concise and does not need to cover everything that is talked about in this book. Do your best to keep the title to around 5 or 6 words only.
