Basic Instruction for Toddlers and Children

- 1. Know what you want them to do before you give instruction**
- 2. Clearly Communicate the instruction**
- 3. Model instruction if necessary**
- 4. Child Should Acknowledge that the Instruction has been Received**
- 5. Parent Should Have the Child Repeat the Instruction Back**
- 6. Give Praise for a job well done**
