Community can mean different things to different people. But the Bible describes biblical community as the family of God together through Jesus (Matthew 12:50). And the family of Jesus is a network of people who love each

other and live a shared life together in a way that is committed, devoted, and loyal to God and one another. Community in the Bible comes through being united with Christ, and united with one another as part of God's purposes in the world. This handout gives a summary of some of the ways we are trying to build biblical community at Calvary Boise, so we can express our shared love of Jesus as we follow Him together.

The primary way we are seeking to follow Jesus together is in Calvary Communities. Think of these groups more as a community of people rather than just a Bible study. A typical Calvary Community gathering could include a meal or snacks and getting to know others, discussion of a Bible passage, prayer for one another, or a time to reach out to friends and neighbors. But they are so much more! We want to equip all at Calvary Boise to make disciples who love Jesus, love His people, and love the lost.

We also understand that getting involved in community can be hard, scary or daunting. So, we are have a variety of ways to help you develop authentic relationships. This booklet also outlines things like Meet Ups, Men's & Women's Bible Studies, and Care Groups. All of these other options provide entry points or supplemental learning communities to help you grow in Christ in the context of the family of God here at Calvary Boise. My prayer is that, in this season, you will see what a great joy it is to live connected and committed in biblical community. I'm praying for and anticipating God's work in our lives!
