Getting started...

Jesus had complete control over the details of His Last Supper (vs. 12-21)

The Lord's Supper reminds us of Jesus' sacrifice and our hope (vs. 22-26)

Thoughts for discussion...

What is it about a meal that allows people to connect at a different level?

Do you find the biblical language of sacrifice difficult? Read Revelation 5:9-12. Why do we think of Jesus as a "Lamb" who was slain for us?

After reading Mark 14:22-24, what is the significance of the bread when we think about the Lord's Supper? What does the cup represent?

Has your family ever considered dinner a time to worship? In what ways do Jesus and the disciples worship throughout this passage (hint: verses 22-23 and 26)?

Read 1 Corinthians 11:23-26. Why do Christians keep doing Communion?

Why do we seem to have such a difficult time living in gratitude to Christ for His sacrifice on our behalf?

Consider singing a song together, reminding yourselves of the goodness of Christ's sacrifice for us.

Finish your discussion by asking God to help you appreciate Christ's sacrifice on your behalf. Ask for strength to live in gratitude each day.
