


Happy Holy Week

REJOICE IN THE LORD

Palm Sunday, April 5 Read John 12:12-13

Trace your child's hands on green paper 3-4 times (or white paper; if you used white paper, plan to color the hand prints green). Cut out traced hands, place 3-4 hands and tape to a stick, ruler, or dowel. Then plan to wave the hands around and wave as we sing "Hosanna" in our Palm Sunday service via Livestream.



Mauudy Thursday, April 9 Read Matthew 26:17-30

As a family have a time of breaking bread and drinking juice together. Reflect on the importance of remembering Christ and His sacrifice. Share with your family about the Lord's Supper and the importance of remembering Christ and His last meal with the disciples in the Upper Room.




Monday, April 6 Read John 13: 1-17

Fill a bucket with water. Grab a few towels, gather your family, and share the story found in the scripture. Then take turns washing each other's feet and pray for one another. Encourage each child to find a way today to serve another person in your family!



Good Friday, April 10 Read Isaiah 53:6

Name 5 animals not named in this passage. Discuss what animal is mentioned. God uses the sheep to remind us how easy it is to wonder away from God. Find a sheep pattern and glue cotton balls onto the sheep, remind children how the sheep look to the sheep herder. We need a leader and His name is Jesus.



Tuesday, April 7 Read Luke 22:39-46

Visit a garden or a park and pray there first individually. Then share a prayer together as a family.

"Dear Lord, thank you that we can pray to you about everything. Help us to remember to talk to you about anything. Amen"



Saturday, April 11 Read Matthew 6:28-33

Teach your children to chant "But Sunday is coming!" Find white cupcake wrappers or coffee filters to make your own Easter lilies and attach to a popsicle stick colored green and glue to a dark background paper and place in your front window to display. Then drive around and go on an Easter Lily Scavenger Hunt!



Wednesday, April 8 Read John 12:35-37

As a family make your favorite flavor of cupcakes. Decorate your cupcakes and use candles. Light the candles and talk about how Jesus is the light of the world. People thought Jesus' light had gone out, but at Easter we will remember Jesus is still alive!



Easter Sunday, April 12 Read Matthew 28:6

Greet your family with 'He is Risen!' Bake Resurrection Rolls for breakfast and sing a song of praise to our Lord. Find a few popsicle sticks or large sticks in your yard. Then during the day, go on a walk and find some flowers to flower your own cross as a family. Be sure to take a photo of your family with their cross!
