Job maintains that it is God that has brought about his circumstances. Job's lament is that his suffering has brought about isolation and indifference from his friends. It is also Job's belief that God will vindicate him. Job is in despair, yet he remains strong in his faith in the living God. Regardless of life's circumstances, pray that you would remain strong in your faith in the living God.

Friday: Job 20

The Bible is clear that we must speak the truth, but we must do so in love (Eph. 4:15). This kind of love is what was missing with Zophar. Zophar was right, but he was also wrong. Had he controlled his anger, he might have been more sensitive in his counsel. Pray that when the opportunity arises, you speak the truth to others, but you do it in love.

Saturday: Prayer

Community Pregnancy Center is a Christian, pro-life ministry that exists for the purpose of presenting the love and Gospel of Jesus Christ in word and deed. Pray for this much needed ministry in our community. Pray for like minded ministries across the country and the world.

Monday: Job 16

We can easily find ourselves getting caught up in the spiral of emotional collapse, and Job was in such a situation. Being frustrated with friends can lead to being frustrated with God. How can we deal with problems when we feel like things are going out of control? First, stop listening to bad counsel, and second start listening to good counsel. Through your trials, stay anchored in God, knowing He is working for your good.

Tuesday: Job 17

In today's passage, we see Job losing hope that God will deliver him and sinks into deeper despair. Job had taken his eyes off the Lord. Job no longer thought that God was working for his good but against him. Job felt hopeless and overwhelmed. In his life, the storm might not soon go away, but the storm in his heart could. Job could know peace by focusing on the Lord to recapture his hope. Through whatever trial you experience, focus on the Lord.

Wednesday: Job 18

"The truth is that the wicked do die a horrible death. Bildad was correct in this description. But Job had not sinned grossly against God. He would not face such a terrible fate in the end. Job 18 records Bildad's second speech to Job, a discourse in which he describes the death of the wicked." – Steven Lawson
