In today's reading, Job struggles to understand why God allows the unrighteous to go unpunished. God has set a day of judgment, and it is undoubtedly coming. The only way to escape this final judgment is for sinners to trust in Christ and His work on the cross. We see unrighteousness every day and wonder if God will punish the unrighteous. Rest assured, He will. Our time, however, would be better spent in telling the unrighteous about Christ so that they might be saved from the judgment to come.

# Friday: Job 25

Bildad announced to Job both the sovereignty of God and the depravity of man. Theologically speaking, both truths are accurate. However, what Job needed to hear was the compassion that God has for sinners. We all need to listen to this and be encouraged by knowing God's love for us.

## Saturday: Prayer

Our prayer is for the churches in Nicaragua. We continually pray that Christ is proclaimed through the country and that a revival takes place. We pray for strength, courage, and boldness for the believers. We pray for the health and unity of the churches in Nicaragua.

## Monday: Job 21

Job was looking at what was seen and not what was unseen. Job was choosing only to focus on the temporal life before him. Job was looking to the physical, not the spiritual. What Job needed to do was to look and, by faith, see what was eternal. At times our focus can be less eternal and more temporal. When you see this happening, stop and pray, ask the Lord to reorient your heart so that its focus is where it ought to be.

## **Tuesday: Job 22**

Although the charges were not true and he made every effort to do so, Eliphaz could not convince Job of his guilt. Satan was using Eliphaz in an attempt to subvert Job's faith. This is the type of thing that Satan does. He uses others to cause us to lose confidence in the Lord, as Eliphaz was doing to Job. Many things can cause us to lose confidence in the Lord. Don't let them. Remain confident in the Lord. Continue to trust in Him, who is sovereign and unchanging.

## Wednesday: Job 23

Job desired to present his case before God, like a private court appearance. Job wanted to bring his arguments before God in what he believed would be an airtight case. Job thought, once God heard him, God would drop all charges against Job. Such hope would be in vain, and by wanting to bring his case before God, Job supposed that God had made a mistake. The reality is, God doesn't make mis-takes. He never mishandles a case.
