What do I learn about God?

God is not a God of confusion, but of peace. When it comes to worshiping God order helps edify the church. This is God's will.

Is there anything for which I should repent based on this text?

When it comes to my local church, is there any way that I have promoted myself rather than focusing on the building up of the body?

How might God use this passage to make me look more like Christ?

Christ worshiped the Father in the way that the Father prescribed (praying, singing, adherence to the word). I am to follow His example and to worship the Lord also in these ways.

How does this passage affect evangelism?

In conjunction with the earlier portion of chapter 14, God desires that His Word would be heard. We know when God's Word is clear it can penetrate the hearts of the lost. Lost people don't need mystical experiences, they need to understand the truths of the gospel.

How can I edify the church based on what this passage says?

Seek to edify the church with my gifts rather than being a consumer or self-promoter.
