What do I learn about God?

7:7 says that God has gifted some people for marriage and some people for singleness.

Is there anything for which I should repent based on this text?

For a married person – are you obeying the commands given in this passage that speak of sexual intimacy with your spouse? Note: Please remember that love, cherishing, and nurturing are part of the marriage relationships. Harsh demands for intimacy is not loving.

How might God use this passage to make me look more like Christ?

For a married person – commitment to a spouse in every way

For a single person – living the single life (as long as God may have you in that state) in the way
that Christ lived His life.

How does this passage affect evangelism?

How can I edify the church based on what this passage says?

As the need arises, encourage various married and single people with the truths that are taught in this passage.
