Consider yesterday's proverb in 11:14. Proverbs 12:15 helps us remember that not only are we to seek wisdom from "an abundance of counselors," where there is safety, but to listen to the advice given. It is "the way of the fool" who is "right in his own eyes." It is one thing to seek wisdom; it is another to listen to it. Pray that the Lord would help you in both of these areas, seeking wisdom and listening when it is given.

## Friday: Proverbs 13

"The Hebrew word translated "hastily" in Proverbs 13:11 refers to more than the attempt to gain wealth quickly. It also has the sense of earning money by prohibited means. Unjust weights and measures are an abomination to the Lord (Deut. 25:13–16), and those who earn money by wicked means will surely lose it in the end. They may seem truly wealthy, but they are poor with respect to the things of God, and they will be held accountable for their sin." - Ligonier.org

## Saturday: Prayer

Continue in prayer for the Standridge family serving in Italy. Pray as they search for a location to plant a church. Pray that the Lord would make this clear to them and that much fruit would come from their mission to evangelize the lost in Italy.

### **Monday: Proverbs 9**

Today's chapter focuses on the way of wisdom (1-12) and the way of folly (13-18). The chapter contrasts Lady Wisdom and Lady Folly, where Lady Wisdom is shown to be desirable. As you read through Proverbs 9, pray that the Lord would grant a greater desire in you to pursue wisdom and turn away from folly.

### **Tuesday: Proverbs 10**

"Too many words inevitably result in sin (Proverbs 10:19). Wordly sin just compounds the closely clinging weights of relational conflict, concealed lies, broken trust, a violated conscience, and knowledge of a grieved Holy Spirit. And too much time in the satanic whirlwind of worldly words also takes its toll, weighing down our spirits." - Jon Bloom

### Wednesday: Proverbs 11

"Where there is no guidance, a people falls, but in an abundance of counselors there is safety," (v. 14). A counselor aids another in making wise decisions. The application here encompasses a broad range of decisions. The point is that there is safety in decision-making by seeking guidance from "an abundance of counselors." Pray and ask the Lord to place trusted, wise, and godly people in your life to help you make wise decisions.
