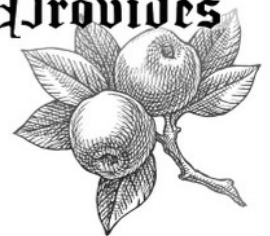

The Prophet God Provides
1 Samuel 1-7



Thursday: Proverbs 17

“An evildoer listens to wicked lips, and a liar gives ear to a mischievous tongue” (v. 4). This proverb is concerned with the one who spreads gossip and the one who listens. One can easily get caught up in gossip, but remember what the Apostle Paul tell us in Ephesians 4:29: “Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.”

Friday: Proverbs 18

“This is a recurring theme of the book of Proverbs. ‘A fool takes no pleasure in understanding, but only in expressing his opinion’ (Prov. 18:2). The agenda of a fool in conversation is getting things off his chest. Even when he is not speaking, he is not truly listening. He is simply shaping what he will say next. His next volley in the conversation is not returning the ball you served, but serving a new ball.” - Tedd Tripp

Monday: Proverbs 14

Consider Proverbs 14:20 & 21. Verse 20 shows us how the world works; the poor are disliked, and the rich have friends. Verse 21 commends those who are generous to the poor. The contrast is clear. As Christians, we are not to look like the world; instead, we seek to love our neighbors regardless of their status. Read Mark 12:30-31 and pray that the whole of the Great Commandment would be true in your life.

Tuesday: Proverbs 15

“Proverbs 15:31 says, ‘The ear that listens to life-giving reproof will dwell among the wise.’ This wise correction is not damaging or hurtful; it helps. It’s loving in its intention and accurate in its assessment. Though often hard at the time it’s given, it results in more joy or peace.” - Deepak Reju

Wednesday: Proverbs 16

Proverbs 16:32 points us to be “slow to anger.” James 1:19 provides the same wisdom when stating we are to be “slow to anger.” James also provides the reason to be “quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger.” It is because anger “does not produce the righteousness of God” (James 1:20). 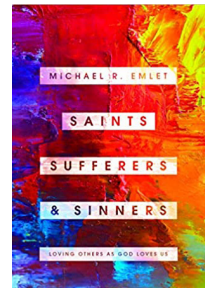
Sermon Application
