Tuesday: Proverbs 20

Proverbs 20:1 is mostly self-explanatory. "Wine is a mocker, strong drink a brawler, and whoever is led astray by it is not wise." The New Testament also speaks to this area of life. "And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit" (Eph. 5:18). The Bible doesn't simply say don't get drunk with wine and state the consequences; it offers the solution: Be "filled with the Spirit." The Bible is not simply a list of dos and don'ts. The Bible provides answers for a transformed life.

Wednesday: Proverbs 21

Consider Proverbs 21:30: "No wisdom, no understanding, no counsel can avail against the Lord." No plan, no matter how well thought out by a person, can keep God from accomplishing His plan and purposes. His enemies can only go as far as He determines. Although the enemies of God may seem to be winning, the ultimate victory already belongs to Jesus, and He is on our side. The believer ought to take comfort in this and praise Him for His sovereignty over their life.
