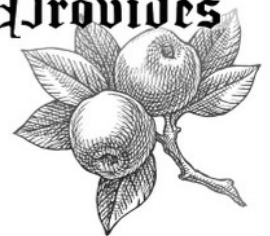

**Thursday: Proverbs 7**

The first five verses of Proverbs 7 are a plea to the son. The appeal is that the son would listen to and take wise instruction from the father. The purpose of this is so that the son would keep himself from the adulteress. The appeal is a warning to keep away from temptations. The specific warning is to keep away from the adulteress, a forbidden woman, “with her smooth words” (v. 5). Pray you would seek to flee temptation and seek wisdom that comes from the Lord.

**Friday: Proverbs 8**

“Having portrayed the adulteress as smooth and seductive in her enticement to sin, our author presents Lady Wisdom as one who also speaks (Prov. 8:1–5). Unlike the evil woman, who speaks in secret and hides her plans from her husband (7:10–20), Lady Wisdom calls out boldly and publicly. She makes her declaration at the gates of the town (8:3). Lady Wisdom is not limited in her discourse to narrowly religious matters, but what she has to say can equip the son for all of life.” - Ligonier.org

**Saturday: Prayer**

Continue in prayer for true revival in Nicaragua. Pray for the boldness of the believers to proclaim Christ. Pray that as the gospel is heard, many will confess and repent of sin.

**Monday: Proverbs 4**

In today's reading, we are reminded of the central theme of the Book of Proverbs, the beginning of wisdom is to get wisdom (v. 7). We need to remember that wisdom is grounded in the fear of the Lord (Prov. 1:7), and wisdom is given by the Lord (Prov. 2:6). Pray that you would continually seek wisdom from the Lord and that you would not be prone to spiritual laziness.

**Tuesday: Proverbs 5**

"Proverbs 5:15–20 emphasizes the marital relationship, particularly the sexual intimacy between husband and wife, that will provide the lasting satisfaction that adultery promises but cannot deliver. Verse 15 likens the marital bond to drinking water from one's own well. The image here is of thirst being quenched by cool, clean water that has not been contaminated and the source of which is known because the well has a designated owner."

**Wednesday: Proverbs 6**

Proverbs 6 provides warnings related to several areas, including debt, laziness, sowing discord, lying, and adultery. As you read over this chapter, pray that you would heed these warnings and seek to flee from temptation to Christ.

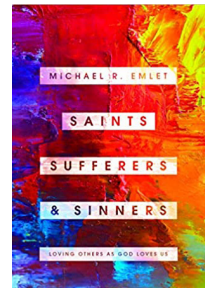
## Sermon Application
