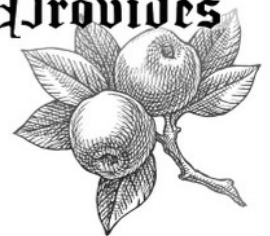

**Thursday: Proverbs 27**

Proverbs 27:1-2 concerns boasting. A person should not boast in prospects of the future, nor should they boast in themselves. When it comes to boasting, our hearts should be in line with the Apostle Paul. “But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world” (Galatians 6:14).

**Friday: Proverbs 28**

“Today’s passage expresses our generosity and trust in God’s provision in proverbial form. Although the Lord is not mentioned specifically in the verse, the immediate context of Proverbs 28:27 gives us ample reason to infer that His presence is assumed in the proverb. After all, verse 25 speaks of trusting in the Lord, which is the characteristic of the person who stands in antithesis to the ‘greedy man’ who ‘stirs up strife.’” – Ligonier.org

**Saturday: Prayer**

This week, as a church, we are praying for the Community Pregnancy Center. Our continued prayer is for the preservation of life. The Pregnancy Center is focused on this very thing. Please pray for their continued efforts, not only for life but also for spreading the gospel in our community.

**Monday: Proverbs 24**

“For the righteous falls seven times and rises again, but the wicked stumble in times of calamity” (v. 16). The point is that a righteous person can repeatedly rise again because the Lord sustains them and their path.

**Tuesday: Proverbs 25**

Proverbs 25:21-22 provide a clear message that we are to repay evil with good. In doing so, it is the hope that our enemies will be repentant. “If your enemy is hungry, give him bread to eat, and if he is thirsty, give him water to drink, for you will heap burning coals on his head, and the LORD will reward you.”

**Wednesday: Proverbs 26**

“Although many of us keep dogs as beloved pets and treat them as members of the family, the ancient Hebrews did not have a great love for these creatures. In fact, dogs were regarded as unclean animals, scavengers who ate animal flesh that was not fit for Israel’s consumption (Ex. 22:31). Thus, to compare a fool to a dog—as Proverbs 26:11 does—powerfully illustrates how the fool should be regarded as a spiritually unclean person.” – Ligonier.org

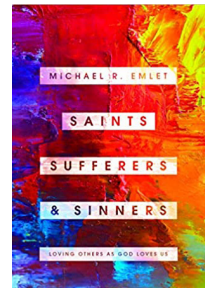
## Sermon Application
