





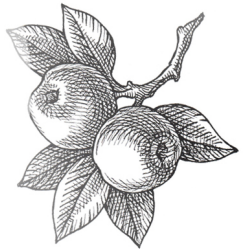

**Thursday: Ecclesiastes 6**

There is vanity in wealth and honor. Ecclesiastes 5:10-6:9 shows us greed vs. contentment. Greed is destructive, whereas contentment is a key to living a godly life in the world. Therefore, pray and ask the Lord to give you greater contentment in Him and what He has given you.

**Friday: Ecclesiastes 7**

“If a name signifies one’s true character, a good name in Ecclesiastes 7:1 signifies a good reputation that is deserved. This name is better than the precious ointment applied to the outer person. Such ointment eventually wears off, but a true good name lasts forever. Precious ointment cannot produce deep relationships with others, but a good name that is deserved enables people to thrive on the personal level.” - Ligonier.org

**Saturday: Prayer**

**Monday: Ecclesiastes 3**

“Solomon says that amassing wealth and possessions is foolish because you can’t take them with you. Instead of placing hope in anything under the sun, he urges you to trust in its Creator. How does that improve life? Well, not only will it make a difference in the judgment, but it provides a pre-sent philosophy of life that frees you from worry and fretting. Because God has set “eternity in a person’s heart” (3:11), you can look forward to a time when temporary things will be forgotten.” - Jay Adams

**Tuesday: Ecclesiastes 4**

“And though a man might prevail against one who is alone, two will withstand him—a threefold cord is not quickly broken” (Ecc. 4:12). The purpose of this verse is to show that there is significant value in plurality as opposed to being alone. Life is better with others. Pray and praise the Lord for those He has placed in your life.

**Wednesday: Ecclesiastes 5**

Ecclesiastes 5:1-7 calls on the reader to fear God. In 3:9-15, there was also a call to fear God, which was motivated by God’s sovereignty. In today’s passage, the motivation to fear God is His holy and righteous character. What is helpful to remember here is that we are to approach the Lord with reverence. Pray that your heart would seek to fear God in adoration and devotion to Him.

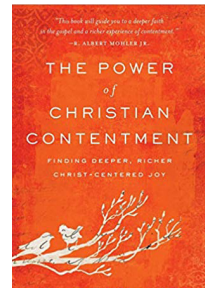


## Sermon Application
