

Thursday: Song of Solomon 4

In today's passage "we find many instances where Solomon and his wife praise each other. These examples, as well as many other biblical passages, remind us of the importance and power of the words we speak to one another. If the tongue can tear down another person (James 3:9), how much more can we use it to build up our spouses with our spoken words?" - Ligonier.org

Friday: Song of Solomon 5 "In the Song of Solomon, the wife says of her husband, 'This is my beloved, and this is my friend' (v.16). I love that expression. She rejoices in her love for him, but it is not just his romantic devotion that thrills her. It is not his machismo or his leadership that causes her heart to sing. What is it? She is glad that he is her friend. That's the kind of relationship husbands should cultivate. It is a deep sense of intimate, equal sharing of spiritual things. It is a communion together like no other relationship on earth." - John MacArthur

Monday: Song of Solomon 1

"First, this book celebrates marital, sexual intimacy enjoyed as God's good gift. It elevates love with dynamics of care and tenderness, associated with the depths of transparency, intensity, and delight between husband and wife. When read, one quickly recognizes the Goddesigned, benevolent, and powerful instrument of sexual intimacy within marriage. Tuesday: Song of Solomon 2

"But Song of Solomon 2:15 tells us that it is 'the little foxes that spoil the vineyards.' Little areas of our life feel so minuscule and unimportant. It's easy to dismiss these things as inconsequential, if not petty, in the grand scope of things. Undoubtedly, following God's ways is certainly about obedience in bigger things, but it is also about choosing to submit to his will in the little details." - Adam Cavalier

"Whom my soul loves" (v. 1). There is an expression of love, and that love is exclusive. This exclusive love comes from the soul, which refers to the whole person, that encompasses desires, thoughts, and feelings.


