

Thursday: Psalm 119:49-56

"Psalm 119:49–56 emphasizes the role of the Word of God in the day of trouble, stressing the inherent power of Scripture to bring life and assurance to God's people, and to comfort them in affliction. This power exists by virtue of the fact that it is the very speech of the Lord Himself, who is present when His Word is read or spoken to confirm its truth to His elect and assure us of His presence (Rom. 8:15–17; 10:17)." - Ligonier.org

Friday: Psalm 119:57-64

"When I think on my ways, I turn my feet to your testimonies; I hasten and do not delay to keep your commandments" (vv. 59-60). When each Christian considers their life, they are to think of their own conduct constantly. The goal is to bring one's character into greater conformity to God's commandments. Our prayer is that the Lord would continue to change hearts to bring us into greater conformity with Him.

Saturday: Prayer

Our outreach prayer this week is for the churches in Nicaragua. Pray the Lord continues to strengthen and encourage their hearts. Pray that many are drawn to the truth of Christ and are convicted of sin and trust in Him as Savior.

Monday: Psalm 119:17-24

"And keep thy word." This should be the rule, the object, and the joy of our life. We may not wish to live and sin; but we may pray to live and keep God's word. Being is a poor thing if it be not well being. Life is only worth keeping while we can keep God's word; indeed, there is no life in the highest sense apart from holiness." - C. H. Spurgeon

Tuesday: Psalm 119:25-32

"Although the exact background of today's passage remains unknown, Psalm 119:25–32 illustrates the importance of divine illumination as we read God's Word and the kind of comprehension and obedience that the Lord desires from us. C.H. Spurgeon considers comprehension and obedience in relation to this passage, telling us that the psalmist is praying, 'Give me a deep insight into the practical meaning of thy word; let me get a clear idea of the tone and tenor of thy law." - Ligonier.org

Wednesday: Psalm 119:33-48

Read today's passage as a prayer back to God. Ask the Lord to teach, give, lead, and turn your heart that understands and desires to keep His commandments. Ask the Lord to "incline" your "heart" to His "testimonies and not to selfish gain!"
