Thursday: Psalm 119:1-8

The first few verses of Psalm 119 describe those who are blessed. These are those who “walk in the law of the Lord” (v. 1), who keep commandments, and “seek him with their whole heart” (v. 2). The call is to “walk in his ways” (v. 3) and to diligently keep His precepts (v. 4). There is a yearning to pursue the Lord with the whole heart eagerly. Pray that this would be true of you and everyone in the congregation.

Friday: Psalm 119:9-16

“Psalm 119 takes a special interest in the ongoing place of the Word of God in the life of the believer. Having proclaimed a great blessing on those who endeavor to obey the Lord according to His law (vv. 1-8), the psalmist expands on his point in verses 9-16, emphasizing the practicality of putting Scripture to work in one’s life. The key verse in this section is verse 11, in which the psalmist confesses that he has stored up God’s Word in his heart in order that he might not sin against the Lord.” - Ligonier.

Saturday: Prayer^{org}

The mission of the Community Pregnancy Center is to “affirm life through evangelism, education, counseling, and practical assistance.” The Center strives for a “culture where the Gospel of Jesus Christ transforms lives, and all people acknowledge that life begins at conception and choose life for the unborn.” Continue in fervent prayer for the Community Pregnancy Center.

Monday: Song of Solomon 6

“Men who sit in the restaurant looking meticulously through the menu, for hours and hours, drinking the free water but never ordering, do not know the pleasure of God’s covenant meal. They do not eat from the table of marital love. Perpetual daters have never savored the rare sweetness of these words: “I am my beloved’s and my beloved is mine” (Song of Solomon 6:3). They pass, like I once did, on the three-course meal of possessing, belonging, and enjoying a creature fit for them within the safety of commitment.” - Greg Morse

Tuesday: Song of Solomon 7

“I am my beloved’s, and his desire is for me” (Song 7:10). “King Solomon’s life tells the story of how a wise man became a very foolish one. The love in the Song of Songs, so rich with exclusive affection, eventually devolved into 700 wives and 300 concubines. But the words of his Song, authored by a greater hand and heart, call us to survey and savor God’s great love for us in Jesus. And not just his love for us in general, but his love for each one of us in particular.” - Scotty Smith

Wednesday: Song of Solomon 8

“The woman asks to be set as a seal on the heart and arm of her husband, referring to his feelings and attitudes as well as his actions (Song 8:6). Essentially, she wants to be bound not to just a part of him but to all that he is. This is because of the strength of her love and her jealousy for him. Here, jealousy is a positive virtue.” - Ligonier.org

Song of Solomon concludes all of the books in the Wisdom Project. The rest of the year will go through a deeper look at Psalm 119.

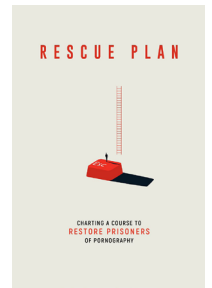

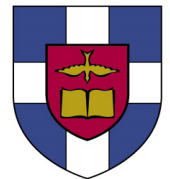
Rescue Skills & Rescue Plan by Deepak Reju & Jonathan D. Holmes
