

**CONTENTS** 

God, enthroned in heaven, is unconcerned with those who plot and resist His rightful authority. This passage tells us that God sits and laughs at such things (v. 4). God sits enthroned over all of the earth. Human powers are no threat to His rule. As God is unconcerned over such things, we also should not be concerned.

# Friday: Psalm 3

"I lay down and slept; I woke again, for the Lord sustained me" (v.5). God sustains, and God protects. The psalmist remembered how God has cared for him in the past. The past has built confidence for the present, enabling him to walk by faith. It is because of this that the psalmist can sleep in the face of danger. Remember how the Lord has cared for you in the past. Praise Him for it, and may this be a help to you when struggling in the present.

# Saturday: Prayer

This week our outreach prayer is for the students and staff at Indian Bible College. Continue to pray for their growth in Christlikeness and that the college is used to evangelize the communities around them.

# Monday: Job 41

God pointed out that Job cannot control the mighty sea creature known as the leviathan. Job was not as big as he thought himself to be, and he needed to realize this fact. Job had expected God to answer him when He was answerable to God. We truly have an awesome God. Yet we're all but little servants of our awesome God.

# Tuesday: Job 42

In this final chapter of the book of Job, Job repents of his arrogance. Job had a renewed sight of God that exposed his arrogance. Job recognizes and acknowledges God's power and sovereignty. Pray that God would humble your heart to see and repent of any pride or arrogance. Pray that God would consistently renew your sight of Him.

# Wednesday: Psalm 1

This psalm reminds us that in the end, there are only two ways to live. There is the way of the wicked and the way of the righteous. This psalm also instructs the righteous on how they are to live by delighting in the law of the Lord and meditate on it. Pray that as you begin reading, through the Book of Psalms, you stay focused on meditating on Scripture and ask the Lord for greater insight.
