Thursday: Job 29

In this passage, we see Job remembering how things were before his sufferings began. Job enjoyed close fellowship with God, and he enjoyed great blessings. While going through a trial, the Christian is better served by looking to the future rather than remembering the past. Remember what God has for you, good, because He is working for your good.

Friday: Job 30

In today's passage, Job cries out, amid pain, as it seems that God has deserted him. While in deep suffering, remember that God has not abandoned you. While suffering, God is good and always does good. Trust Him.

Saturday: Prayer

Pray for the Standridge family serving in Italy. Over the next few years, they seek to develop a team and start a church in an unchurched area of Italy. Pray that the Lord would encourage them in this effort and provide for this opportunity.

Monday: Job 26

In Job's rebuke of Bildad, he magnifies God's great power and that He is beyond what humans can comprehend. We also know this to be true. God alone is worthy, and we, too, should magnify God and give Him the glory that He alone is worthy to receive.

Tuesday: Job 27

In this chapter, while in the middle of seeming injustice, Job wanted God's justice to rule on his behalf. Job felt that he was right and that injustice seemed to be winning. Job's view of God was becoming distorted. Just like Job, when we go through trials, the way we view God can become distorted. We must have the right focus on God. We do this through being in His word, praying, and having the correct spiritual attitude.

Wednesday: Job 28

Job recognizes that only God knows where to find wisdom (28:23-28). Wisdom is from God Himself, and true wisdom comes from fearing the Lord. It is clear that we are to seek His wisdom, and He desires to give it. James 1:5: "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him."

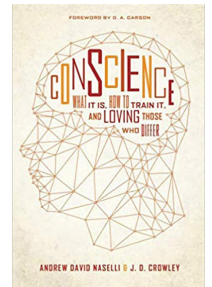
Sermon Application
