THE LADY WHO SAVED CHRISTMAS 2 Kings 11

MONDAY

Prophet Project: Malachi 3:16-18

In spite of all the talk of judgment against those who turn from the Lord, God reminds his people that there is a book in which he has written the names of those who are his. This is a beautiful picture that will not forget them. You may wish to look up other passages in which the Scripture refers to the Book of Life. These can be found in Exodus 32:32-34, Nehemiah 13:14, Psalm 69:28, Daniel 12:1, and Revelation 20:12.

TUESDAY

Prophet Project: Malachi 4:1-6

In verse 2, "the sun of righteousness" is a reference to the Messiah. Like the sun that drives away the darkness, bringing light and joy, the "sun of righteousness" will dispell gloom, oppression, and injustice. The writer is speaking of a great hope that we now have and know of, as written in the New Testament. That great hope is built on Jesus Christ. Read the lyrics from the hymn The Solid Rock and praise Christ that He is the solid rock in which our hope is based:

"My hope is built on nothing less, Than Jesus' blood and righteousness, I dare not trust the sweetest frame, But wholly lean on Jesus' Name, On Christ the solid Rock I stand, All other ground is sinking sand, All other ground is sinking sand"

Jonathan Edwards Resolution 48 on Spiritual Life:

Resolved, constantly, with the utmost niceness and diligence, and the strictest scrutiny, to be look-ing into the state of my soul, that I may know whether I have truly an interest in Christ or no; that when I come to die, I may not have any negligence respecting this to repent of.

December 27, 2019

Friday

Jonathan Edwards Resolution 31 on Relationships:

Resolved, never to say anything at all against anybody, but when it is perfectly agreeable to the highest degree of Christian honor, and of love to mankind, agreeable to the lowest humility, and sense of my own faults and failings, and agreeable to the golden rule; often, when I have said anything against anyone, to bring it to, and try it strictly by the test of this Resolution.

THURSDAY

December 26, 2019

Jonathan Edwards Resolution 8 on Character:

Resolved, to act, in all respects, both speaking and doing, as if nobody had been so vile as I, and as if I had committed the same sins, or had the same infirmities or failings as others; and that I will let the knowledge of their failings promote nothing but shame in myself, and prove only an occasion of my confessing my own sins and misery to God.

SATURDAY

December 28, 2019

Jonathan Edwards Resolution 57 on Suffering:

Resolved, when I fear misfortunes and adversities, to examine whether have done my duty, and resolve to do it; and let it be just as providence orders it, I will as far as I can, be concerned about nothing but my duty and my sin.
