## WEDNESDAY

Prophet Project: Isaiah 40:1-8

“The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever,” Isaiah 40:8. Everything else will fade away; God’s word will not. It is the word of God that gave hope and life to weak people. This passage is more than fact; it was a glorious promise of hope to the people of God. Pray and ask the Lord to give you a greater passion for His word knowing that it will stand forever.

## FRIDAY

Prophet Project: Isaiah 41:1-29

“When life gives you lemons,” the saying goes, “make lemonade.” That’s great optimism, but it leaves God out of the picture. Instead, Christians must see those “lemons” as coming from the Sovereign Lord we read about in verse 4. So perhaps the saying should be something like, “When life gives you lemons, remember that the Lord is in control of all things. He has a purpose, and He will accomplish His plans. You can trust Him always.” Rejoice, dear Christian, that you know the One in charge of all things and rest in Him.

## THURSDAY

Prophet Project: Isaiah 40:9-31

When we consider God’s promises and the reliability of them, they call for a public announcement that is wholehearted and without fear. The message is to be proclaimed whatever the circumstances are at the time. In this passage, the greatness of God is boldly proclaimed. In this we are reminded of 2 Timothy 4:2, “preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching.” You may not be the pastor preaching from a pulpit, but all Christians are called to preached the word to the unbelieving world around us. Speak boldly of God and courageously proclaim the gospel.

## SATURDAY

Prophet Project: Isaiah 42:1-17

In today’s passage, we read about the Lord’s chosen Servant. The Servant referred to here is the Messiah. We read of things fulfilled in Jesus Christ. Read over this passage a few times and take note of all that is said. Pray and ask the Lord to give you a greater understanding of what’s been written. Praise Jesus Christ for all He has done and all that He will.
