The Lost Smile of God

Psalm 80

MONDAY

Prophet Project: Isaiah 42:18-25

In today's passage, we see how God's own people are as in much need of deliverance as the nations are. As we look at the dark world around us, it's easy to point and say you need Christ, and this is true. However, we must never forget, even though a person has been saved through faith in Christ, this does not mean that they need Him any less. Pray and ask God for an ever-growing desire to see your need for Christ and to seek Him more each day.

TUESDAY

Prophet Project: Isaiah 43:1-28

One of the many challenges of living in a fallen world is that we can easily fix our eyes on our circumstances rather than keeping them on our God. As you read today's passage, notice God's description of Himself and His actions for His people. No matter what you're walking through, remember that your God is greater.

<u>Wednesday</u>

Prophet Project: Isaiah 44:1-8

As you read through this passage, concentrate on how God reassures His people, in verses 1-5. God is reassuring them that blessing them is His final purpose for them. Our God is not a distant God who leaves us on our own. Our God is a God who loves, who blesses, who comforts. Praise Him for all that He is and all that He does for you.

Friday

Prophet Project: Isaiah 45:1-25

"The Lord works in mysterious ways." Indeed, He does. In today's passage, we read about Him using Cyrus, the evil king of Babylon, for His own purposes of restoring Jerusalem. As we look out at the world's event, we see much evil and become confused. The Lord, however, suffers no confusion and is actually the Sovereign behind it all, wellbeing and calamity (v. 7). Dear Christian, even when you don't understand, you must still trust. Our God is the LORD, and there is no other!

Thursday

Prophet Project: Isaiah 44:9-28

When it comes to idols they do not profit, idols are nothing, and those who worship idols will be put to shame. Take time to consider the idols in your life. Ask the Lord to help you to identify those areas that may have become idols in your life. When you identify, idols in your life, ask the Lord to help you to forsake them and to repent. Meditate on 1 Chronicles 16:23-27: "Sing to the LORD, all the earth! Tell of his salvation from day to day. Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples! For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised, and he is to be feared above all gods. For all the gods of the peoples are worthless idols, but the LORD made the heavens. Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and joy are in his place."

SATURDAY

Prophet Project: Isaiah 46:1-13

False gods, in this case, the gods of Babylon, fail those who worship them. In contrast, the God of Israel saves His people. Those who worship false gods and those who worship self the Lord will humiliate and put to shame. God has and will continue to demonstrate that He is the one true God. Praise the Lord that He has opened your heart to the truth that He is the one true God. Pray for those around you who seek to worship anything other than the one true God. Ask the Lord to provide you with the opportunity and the boldness to proclaim the truth to them.
