

TUESDAY

Prophet Project: Ezekiel 34:1-24

In today's passage, we read about the Lord's judgment upon the shepherds of Israel. Instead of caring for the people, they preyed upon them in order to gain for themselves. The Lord would not allow this type of self-centered leadership, so He declared that He would step in to be the shepherd of His people and do what the faithless shepherds would not. What great love we see displayed here from our Heavenly Father; He did not send others to rescue His sheep, but declared that He would rescue them Himself. There are times in life when we can feel as though God is absent, but yet again, we are reminded of the faithfulness of God. He never leaves His people without His loving care, and that's good news.

WEDNESDAY

Prophet Project: Ezekiel 34:25-31

“And I will make them and the places all around my hill a blessing, and I will send down the showers in their season; they shall be showers of blessing,” (34:26). The “showers of blessing” not only refers to literal rainfall but the abundance of blessings from God. In this passage, God reminds His people and Christians today of who He is. Our God is a loving God who cares for His people. “And you are my sheep, human sheep of my pasture, and I am your God, declares the Lord God” (34:31).

FRIDAY

Prophet Project: Ezekiel 36:1-38

As we read through the prophets together, the amount of judgment and sorrow we see can sometimes be overwhelming. That’s what makes passages like today’s so sweet. The people of God may endure extremely difficult situations in this life, but we are always optimistic because we know the future the Lord has in store for us. We may not see these promises in our lifetime, but we can rest assured that the Lord does not lie. He will do everything He says, and that gives us a tremendous amount of hope. Let today’s reading remind you that no matter what your current circumstances may look like, we have an amazing future ahead that the Lord Himself has promised and secured.

THURSDAY

Prophet Project: Ezekiel 35:1-15

Take a closer look at verse 5 from this passage. “Because you cherished perpetual enmity and gave over the people of Israel to the power of the sword at the time of their calamity, at the time of their final punishment.” God will judge Edom because of their enmity against Israel and Edom’s bloodshed against the Israelites trying to escape the Babylonians. The point is God does not judge indiscriminately or at random. If there is a judgment against anyone or any people, it is because God is just in His judgment. God is just to judge us because of our sin. As a Christian, pray and thank the Lord for Christ who suffered the penalty for your sin on the cross.

SATURDAY

Prophet Project: Ezekiel 37:1-28

“The Lord promises that He will bring these bodies—the nation of Israel—back to life by His sovereign act (vv. 3–6). Moreover, He says the proclamation of His Word will accomplish their resurrection. God has Ezekiel prophesy over the bones, and at that point they are restored to life and given the Holy Spirit (vv. 7–14). The Lord is saying that He will restore His people through the foolishness of preaching. As part of this restoration, Israel and Judah will be reunited as one nation in God’s hand under David, namely, the Messiah (vv. 15–28).” - Ligonier Ministries
