## WEDNESDAY

Prophet Project: Daniel 3:1-30

Today's reading is a familiar passage as Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were delivered from the fiery furnace. We see here, God enacting a miracle. When He does so, He is in control of the details of the supernatural act as there can be no other explanation. Miracles are not something that we can fully understand, but take on faith because of the work the Lord has done in our hearts. Then you read through Scripture and come across one of His miracles, may that be a reminder of just how great the God of the Bible truly is.

## FRIDAY

Catch Up Day

Take time today to praise and thank the Lord for His word. Thank Him for all that He has been teaching you. Think back over your time reading through Scripture and see how the Lord has grown you. Praise Him for it and give Him glory.

## THURSDAY

Prophet Project: Daniel 4:1-18

In today's reading, we see a beautiful picture of what God did in the life of Nebuchadnezzar. He went from being a persecutor of those faithful to God to himself becoming a witness to the faith. This story is familiar to us as we consider the likes of the Apostle Paul. At the same time, it might be familiar as you consider your own personal testimony of salvation. It is God who changes hearts to become faithful and give praise to Him. Praise God today for the work He has done in your heart.

## SATURDAY

Prophet Project: Daniel 4:19-37

"At the end of the days I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted my eyes to heaven, and my reason returned to me, and I blessed the Most High, and praised and honored him who lives forever," (Dan 4:34). For Nebuchadnezzar to live, his "eyes to heaven" is something that was enabled by God and not of himself. Consider John 6:44: "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day." No one turns from a life a sin to faith in trust in Christ unless that person is enabled to do so by the Father. For those who have done so ought to praise God every day for this truth. By ourselves, we would never choose God, but because of His great mercy in choosing us, we too can lift our "eyes to heaven" to praise and honor "him who lives forever."
