MONDAY

Prophet Project: Hosea 2:1-13

"Plead with your mother, plead—for she is not my wife," (Hosea 2:2a). The plea here is a plea for repentance. It is repeated twice for emphasis. When there is a call for someone to repent it needs to be emphasized. If there is a brother or sister in Christ, who needs to repent of their sin, emphasize this need in their life. Also, remember the need for you to repent in your life as you confess your sin to the Lord.

TUESDAY

Prophet Project: Hosea 2:14-23

As you read today's passage, remember what you read yesterday. Israel's adultery was grotesque and the Lord painted that picture well. Yet, today, we see that His mercy extends farther than we can fathom. Israel deserved wrath, but the Lord made a promise to shower them with His grace and cleanse their repulsive adultery. Here in Hosea, just as in the life of Jesus, we see that the Lord loves to save sinners.

FRIDAY

Prophet Project: Hosea 3:1-5

In this chapter Hosea returns to his own marriage situation, which is still an image for God and Israel. The house of David is where Israel's hope, like Judah's, lies. The Lord pursues Israel, the adulteress, and not another people. The Lord is a pursuer of His people, even those who have been unfaithful to Him. Consider how unfaithful you have been in your life. The Lord pursued you and continues to do so because of His love for you. Take time to praise Him for His love to you.

Prophet Project: Hosea 5:1-15

In verse 3 of today's reading, the Lord declared, "I know Ephraim, and Israel is not hidden from me..." This is the theological idea of God's omniscience. That is the reality that God knows everything and nothing can be hidden from Him. Sometimes we are tempted to think that because other people may not know about a secret sin we are hiding, we're in a safe place. The truth, however, is that the Lord always knows and that sense of safety is not real. Is there any sin in your life today that you're harboring? If so, confess and repent of it for the Lord knows all.

THURSDAY

Prophet Project: Hosea 4:1-19

The charges against Israel are framed in legal language, like that of a lawsuit. The charges, lying, murder, stealing, adultery, are offenses against God's law, particularly those of the Ten Commandments. God takes these things seriously, and we are to as well. Pray and ask the Lord to reveal areas of your life where you may have sinned where you need to confess to the Lord. Thank Him for His faithfulness to forgive.

SATURDAY

Prophet Project: Hosea 6:1-7:16

In today's passage we see that Israel and Judah are more than just unrepentant. Their sins are worse than simply violating the law. There was a refusal to accept or be associated with the gracious covenant that is the foundation of their life and hope. It was these people that God pursued. Perhaps you know of someone or have heard about someone, who claimed to be Christian but then no longer wanted to be associated with Christianity. Pray for them. Pray that true repentance takes place. Pray for hearts that are truly converted for the Lord.
