

MONDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Matthew 22:34-46

“And he said to him, ‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets’” (vv. 37-40). Loving others, as yourself, signifies the significant responsibility to seek the greatest good for our neighbor’s both Jew and Gentile. The call to love others is not just for a specific group of people. Pray and ask the Lord to help you to love your neighbor as yourself, to seek their greatest good for the glory of God.

TUESDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Matthew 23:1-39

In today’s passage, we read of Jesus pronouncing woes upon those Pharisees for their actions. Before this, Jesus issued a warning to the people and his disciples not to follow the false leadership of the Pharisees. As Christians, we must remain vigilant, knowing that there are false teachers who would seek to leads us away from true teaching. The tactics of false teachers can be deceptive and look much like good teaching. Here we are reminded that to know true from false teaching is to know the Bible. When we know what is true, from God’s word, we will be more easily able to spot false teaching. Pray and ask the Lord to help you to be more faithful in your reading and study of Scripture.

WEDNESDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Matthew 24:1-28

It's easy to come to our passage today and focus on the specific detail of Jesus' words. Jesus prophesies about His second coming, a time that will be characterized by great tribulation. The picture Jesus paints is one of immense pain and suffering that is mere "birth pangs" of what is to follow. Yes, we ought to study God's Word and mine it for all its worth. But don't lose sight of the big picture in this passage. Jesus will return. He will come again, but this time he will not come as a lamb but as a lion, a conquering King. Are you living in a way that shows your belief in His imminent return?

THURSDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Matthew 24:29-51

After telling them of the signs that will accompany His return, Jesus focuses on the timing of these events. His main point seems to be that His return will come suddenly and unexpectedly (v.36). Jesus gives a very clear and pointed message in light of the secrecy of His return. He calls us to "be on alert" (v.42) so that when He comes, He will find us faithful (v.45-46). How will you fare when Jesus returns? Are you being faithful and obedient to God's Word?

FRIDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Matthew 25:1-30

When reading the Parable of the Talents, twice the master states "well done, good and faithful servants" as praise to the servants who were faithful in using their gifts and potential. Contrast these servants with the third servant whose actions resulted in laziness and bad stewardship. The gifts, abilities, and talents given to believers are to be used for glorifying God and furthering His Kingdom. The Christian has been called to be a good and faithful servant. Consider what the Lord has blessed you with and how you might use those gifts for the glory of God.

SATURDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Matthew 25:31-46

"Then he will say to those on his left" (v. 41). For those who are not sheep (those who will "inherit the kingdom"), are the goats, and they are condemned to the "eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels," (v. 41). In one sense, for believers, there is great comfort in being one of His sheep. In another sense, there is an urgency to preach the gospel. Knowing what is to come, for those who are goats, ought to compel us to share the good news of Christ with the unbelieving world. Think about those in your life who you know are not believers and need to hear the gospel. Pray and ask the Lord to give you opportunities to share Christ with them.
