Mark 5:1-20					

#### MONDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Luke 20:41-47

There is a warning in today's passage: Beware of the Scribes. Although not all of the scribes deserved the condemnation (v. 47), many of them did, and they will receive condemnation because of their hypocrisy. These Scribes made a pretense of long prayers and greeting people in the marketplace. However, as Scribes, they were also estate planners for widows. They were able to convince widows to support the temple and their work for their monetary gain. We are to beware of those who act the part of a godly person, but who are seeking profit for themselves.

# TUESDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Luke 21:1-19

The poor widow, giving out of her poverty, had put in more than all that had given out of abundance (v. 3). It is not the size of the offering that God measures, but the sincerity and selflessness of the heart of the giver.

Wednesday

Gospel & Acts Project: Luke 21:20-28

"Now when these things begin to take place, straighten up and raise your heads because your redemption is drawing near" (v. 28). The signs, of the tribulation, mark the last days. For the true believer, these signs are a cause of joy, expectation, and triumph. The believer is to raise their head as the redeemed will be reunited with Christ forever.

# THURSDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Luke 21:29-38

In today's passage, there are two warnings, from Jesus, concerning His return. Watch yourselves and stay awake at all times. Both of these involve being prepared and remaining faithful. We are to be spiritually alert, and this is made possible through prayer, especially. Take the time to pray and ask the Lord to help you to remain awake and spiritually alert, to watch yourself, and to be prepared.

# Gospel & Acts Project: Luke 22:1-13

FRIDAY

"And the chief priests and the scribes were seeking how to put him to death, for they feared the people" (v.2). The scribes and the chief priests had already determined their verdict about Jesus. The only thing they had left to determine was how they were to get rid of Him. Since Jerusalem was full of people, due to the Passover season, they plotted in secret in hopes of getting rid of Jesus after Passover. However, the events unfolded exactly as God had intended and on His timetable. What God has determined will not be changed by any plot or scheme of man. God was sovereign over these events, and He is sovereign over the events today. Because of this, we can live confidently, knowing that God is in control.

#### SATURDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: Luke 22:14-34

John Piper, on Luke 22:31-32: "God broke the back of Peter's pride and self-reliance that night in the agony of Satan's sieve. But he did not let him go. He turned him around and forgave him and restored him and strengthened his faith. And now it was Peter's mission to strengthen the other ten. 'And when you have turned again, strengthen your brothers.' Jesus provided for the ten by providing for Peter. The strengthened becomes the strengthener. There is a great lesson here for us. Sometimes God will deal with you directly, strengthening your faith alone in the wee hours of the morning when everyone else is asleep. But most of the time (we might say ten-elevenths of the time) God strengthens our faith through another person."
