WEDNESDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: John 19:38-42

“It is sin to hide our allegiance to Christ (Matt. 10:32–33), but it is not unforgivable. The key is that we repent of being ashamed or afraid of our identification with Christ and publicly declare that we are His disciples. This is what Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus did when they took Jesus’ body for burial. If we have been ashamed of Jesus, let us repent today and ask the Lord to give us the courage to be known as disciples of Christ.” - Ligonier.org

FRIDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: John 20:11-18

In this passage, we see that Mary, for whatever reason, “did not know that it was Jesus” (v. 14) even though Jesus was standing right there. It wasn’t until He said her name that she recognized Him. This reminds us of John 10:27: “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.” Those who are part of Jesus’ flock are those who believe, those who have been chosen by Him. If you are part of His flock, praise Him for it, and ask Him to help you follow Him more closely.

THURSDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: John 20:1-10

“The chapter we have now begun takes us from Christ’s death to Christ’s resurrection. Like Matthew, Mark, and Luke, John dwells on these two great events with peculiar fullness and particularity. And we need not wonder. The whole of saving Christianity hinges on the two facts, that Christ died for our sins, and rose again for our justification.” - J.C. Ryle

SATURDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: John 20:19-23

“When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord” (v. 20). Jesus did this to show that He was the same One who was crucified. The same human body that was crucified is the same that was standing before them. This leaves no doubt that Jesus truly died and rose again. The evidence is clear; Jesus died and rose so that those who believe in Him would be forgiven of their sin. Be bold for Jesus and spread this message to the world.
