## WRONG PROBLEM; WRONG REMEDY

## Mark 7:1-23

MONDAY

Gospel &amp; Acts Project: John 13:1-20

As Jesus washed the disciple's feet, it was more than just an example of humility, as great of an example as it was. It was also a proof of His love for them. Jesus washed the feet of all the disciples, even that of Judas. Jesus was demonstrating love even for His enemies. Pray and ask the Lord to give you love like Jesus. Pray that you would demonstrate love, not only for your loved ones but for your enemies as well.

## TUESDAY

Gospel &amp; Acts Project: John 13:21-30

In today's passage, Jesus deals His disciples that one of them will betray them. We, having the full story, know of whom Jesus is speaking. However, the disciples had no idea as Judas's outward behavior was similar to that of the others. In other words, Judas acted like everyone else, and because of that, he was not immediately assumed to be the betrayer. This passage reminds us that it is not the outward appearance, but the heart, what's on the inside, that matters.



## WEDNESDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: John 13:31-38

Love is a mark of being a disciple of Jesus. Jesus gives His disciples a new commandment, “that you love one another.” He also tells them how they are to go about doing it: “just as I have loved you; you are also to love one another.” Then Christ explains why they are to love others as He has loved them: “By this, all people will know that you are my disciples if you have love for one another.” When Christians love other Christians, the way Christ loves, they are showing the unbelieving world who they are, Christians. Loving each other, like Christ, sets the Christian apart from the world and the way the world loves. In this passage, Christ tells us who we are to love, how we are to love them, and why it’s essential to do so: So that all people will know that we are His disciples.

## THURSDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: John 14:1-14

“If Jesus’ claim to be the Way and the Life were false, it would hardly be a comfort to us or worth hearing. Thus, Jesus’ revelation of Himself in John 14:6 as the Truth serves to give us confidence in our Lord. He is the source and standard of truth, the One whose revelation in Scripture and in nature form a sure foundation on which to stand. Since Jesus is the Truth, we are not engaging in wish fulfillment when we believe in Him. Instead, we are receiving divine truth. He is fully trustworthy, and because of this we can trust every word of Scripture, for Jesus affirms that God Himself inspired the prophets and Apostles (Matt. 4:4; 19:3–6). The Scriptures are truth. We know this because the Truth—Jesus Christ—has confirmed them.” -Ligonier.org

## FRIDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: John 14:15-31

In today’s passage, Jesus states that He will give “another Helper” (v. 16). This helper is the “Spirit of truth” (v. 17), the Holy Spirit. The Spirit of truth is the source of truth, and He communicates the truth. Apart from Him, no one can know God’s truth. The Father sent the Holy Spirit to indwell believers. As Helper, He comes alongside to encourage and exhort. For the believer, the Holy Spirit is a permanent resident. Take time to pray and thank the Holy Spirit for all that the Spirit has done in your life.

## SATURDAY

Gospel & Acts Project: John 15:1-17

“All other vines are but shadows of Christ. They represent Christ, but he is himself the substance. the essence, the one great reality. He is the truth of all things that exist: ‘I am the true Vine.’ Does anybody ask which is the true Church? All who are vitally joined to Christ are in the true Church, for he says, ‘I am the true Vine.’” - C.H. Spurgeon
