*Mark 11-13*

**Thursday: Psalm 12**

This Psalm laments a community of God's people, dominated by lies from those in positions of authority. In verse 3, the Lord is asked to cut them off. The Lord is being asked to remove those people who "utter lies to his neighbor; with flattering lips and a double heart they speak" (v. 2). Pray that the Lord would guard us (v. 7) against the wicked who prowl among us (v.8).

**Friday: Psalm 13**

In a time of despair, the psalmist asks the Lord for help. Yet through whatever difficult situation this is, their trust is in the Lord. "But I have trusted in your steadfast love; my heart shall rejoice in your salvation. I will sing to the Lord, because he has dealt bountifully with me" (vv. 5-6). May it be the prayer of your heart to trust in His steadfast love, rejoice in His salvation, and sing to the Lord for who He is and what He has done.

**Saturday: Prayer**

Pray for Nico Standridge. Earlier this week, Nico had a medical issue that required him to be taken to the hospital. As of earlier this week, his heart and neurological tests look good, but additional tests were to be done. The Standridge family ask that you "pray for the doctors to have wisdom to find out exactly what happened. Also, you could pray for Nico and for the rest of our family that God would use this event for His glory in our lives."

**Monday: Psalm 9**

“I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart; I will recount all of your wonderful deeds” (v. 1). The idea here is that the whole heart, the entire inner self, would be engaged in loving and praising the Lord. Giving thanks, with the whole heart, is to be done in public as well as private.

**Tuesday: Psalm 10**

Those who are wicked, boastful, and greedy (v. 3) prosper while making the poor and helpless suffer (v. 2). Why does God allow the wicked to get away with such things (v. 1)? The fact is, God doesn’t. Contrary to appearances, seen in verse 1, God does attend to cries for justice (vv. 17-18). The God of the Bible is just, and He hears “the desire of the afflicted” (v. 17).

**Wednesday: Psalm 11**

Today’s Psalm expresses the confidence that the faithful can have, even in a time of crisis. Although we do not know the specific details of this particular event in David’s life, this Psalm helps show us how to face crisis times. The faithful can be confident because it is the righteous Lord that gives us confidence.

## Sermon Application

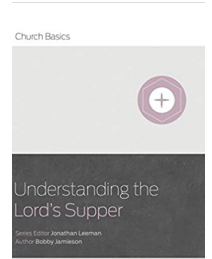
