**Thursday: Psalm 17**

Verses 6-9 of today's passage is a general request for an answer to prayer, and then a specific request for protection, "from the wicked who do me violence, my deadly enemies who surround me." Pray for those

Christians, near and far, who are under the threat of violence. Pray that they remain steadfast in the Lord.

**Friday: Psalm 18**

The Lord is David's strength and a defender against his enemies. David, in his distress, called out to the Lord for help (v. 6). When in distress, do you go to the Lord in prayer, or do you seek to try and resolve it on your own? Pray that your first thought, in every situation, would be to go to Him.

**Saturday: Prayer**

Pray for the Gospel Rescue Mission as they seek to change lives by promoting the gospel of Christ. Pray that the needs of the Mission are met, and the people cared for. Pray for boldness for the staff and the volunteers.

**Monday: Psalm 14**

This Psalm is a lament in which God's people mourn that people, in general, do not seek after God. The result is that they treat God's people with cruelty. When facing such cruel threats, those who are faithful must remember that God is their refuge.

**Tuesday: Psalm 15**

As you read through this Psalm, notice how a worshipper of the Lord is described. They walk blamelessly, do not slander, do not take bribes, etc. It could be said that this Psalm is celebrating the ideal worshipper of the Lord. As you read, pray that your worship would line up with how Scripture describes worship.

**Wednesday: Psalm 16**

"The Lord is my chosen portion and my cup; you hold my lot. The lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; indeed, I have a beautiful inheritance" (vv. 5-6). The provision of the Lord provides satisfaction for the psalmist. God providentially orders the arrangement of our lives, and in this, there is contentment.

## Sermon Application

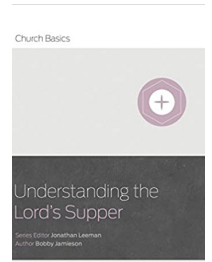
