Thursday: Psalm 22

There is a lament in this Psalm. Even though the Lord has not answered (v. 2), he knows that God remains holy and can be trusted (v. 3-4). Remember, in times of trial and difficulty, that God remains holy. He remains unchanged and can always be trusted.

Friday: Psalm 23

The Lord is a Shepherd who cares for His sheep. As you read this Psalm, read it as a prayer of praise, adoration, and thanksgiving to our great God.

Saturday: Prayer

“Indian Bible College exists to disciple and educate Indigenous Native Christians for lifetimes of biblical ministry and spiritual leadership to their people and the world.” Pray that the Lord would bless the college and their efforts.

Monday: Psalm 19

“The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork” (v. 19). The glory of God is displayed in the sky as it bears witness to the Creator. God’s power and wisdom are in clear view at all times.

Tuesday: Psalm 20

Our trust is “in the name of the Lord our God” (v. 7). God is the One who “saves his anointed” (v. 6). It is because of this our confidence can be placed in Him alone. Pray that He would continue to grow your love and trust in Him.

Wednesday: Psalm 21

To exult means to rejoice or to be openly happy about something. “O LORD, in your strength the king rejoices, and in your salvation how greatly he exults!” (v. 1). Think about all the Lord has done for you. Take time to rejoice, exult and be openly happy about His grace in your life.

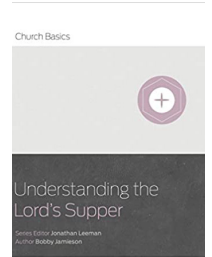
