

CONTENTS

The Psalm reminds us that we are not to be envious of those who do evil and not to fret because of them (v. 1). Justice will come in the end, and God will bring forth righteousness (v. 6, 8). As believers, we are to trust in the Lord (v. 3), delight in Him (v. 4), commit our way to Him (v. 5), be still and wait patiently for the Lord (v. 7), and refrain from anger forsaking wrath.

Friday: Psalm 38

"In Psalm 38, David grasps this truth, that God hates sin and punishes those who disobey Him. God is a wrathful judge as well as a loving Father. Spend some time today and through the weekend confessing your sins before God. Be specific. Recognize that you deserve God's disciplines in your life and praise Him for the mercy He has extended to you. Thank Him for Christ, in whom we have forgiveness of sins." - Ligonier.org

Saturday: Prayer

Continue in prayer for the Standridge family serving in Italy. Pray for their continued adjustment to living in Italy. Pray for evangelistic and preaching opportunities.

Monday: Psalm 34

Today's Psalm is one of thanksgiving for God's care and protection for those who trust in Him. When was the last time you expressed thanks to God for His care and protection? Pray and thank the Lord. Magnify Him and exalt His name (v. 3).

Tuesday: Psalm 35

There are always those who would seek to harm believers. This psalm shows how believers are to pray in light of this. As David cries out for help, we too can cry out to the Lord for help.

Wednesday: Psalm 36

Verses 10-12 of this Psalm is a prayer in response to what came before. David reflects on how God's steadfast love protects from the wicked. Pray and praise the Lord for His steadfast love to you.
