Thursday: Psalm 67

“It begins at the beginning with a cry for mercy. Forgiveness of sin is always the first link in the chain of mercies experienced by us. Mercy is a foundation attribute in our salvation. The best saints and the worst sinners may unite in this petition. It is addressed to the God of mercy, by those who feel their need of mercy, and it implies the death of all legal hopes or claims of merit.” - C.H. Spurgeon on Psalm 67:1

Friday: Psalm 68

Today’s psalm is a hymn where the people of God celebrate His care and protection of Israel. They remember how God brought them out of the wilderness and into their inheritance. As you read this psalm, celebrate how much God has cared and protected you.

Saturday: Prayer

Our outreach prayer is for the Gospel Rescue Mission. Pray for the spread of the gospel through the efforts of the Mission. Pray their needs are met so that they can care for those at the Mission.

Monday: Psalm 64

Those who are righteous, those who are believers, not only rejoice in the Lord but take refuge in Him (v. 10). Meditate on what the Lord has done in your life. Pray that you would take greater joy in knowing that you are a child of God.

Tuesday: Psalm 65

“Praise is due to you” (v. 1). This psalm begins by recognizing that all praise is due to God. Read this psalm as a prayer back to God, praising Him as the God of your salvation.

Wednesday: Psalm 66

“All the earth worships you and sings praises to you; they sing praises to your name” (v. 4). When was the last time, outside of a worship service, that you were singing praises to God? Consider the songs you know that glorify God and are praises to Him. Sing those songs to Him in praise and worship of our great God.

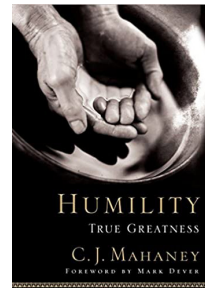
Sermon Application

Humility: True Greatness by C.J. Mahaney

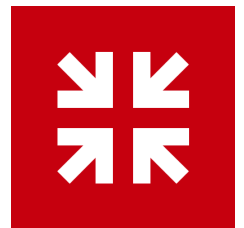
