Thursday: Psalm 52

When surrounded by ruthless enemies, this psalm helps the faithful develop confidence in God's care and protection. Trust in the steadfast love of God and know that you are safe in His keeping (Vv. 8-9).

Friday: Psalm 53

Today's psalm serves to mourn the fact that humankind does not seek after God. The result is that humanity oppresses God's people. Yet great terror will fall on the wicked. (v. 5). God will judge the wicked. Our response is to remain faithful no matter the circumstances.

Saturday: Prayer

Pray for the Community Pregnancy Center's Walk for Life event that was through May 8th. Pray that the event successfully raised awareness and much-needed funds for the Center to continue its life-saving work.

Monday: Psalm 49

“Psalm 49 serves as a necessary reminder to us. The psalmist describes the folly of those who trust riches and honors instead of God. He also paints a vivid picture of the fate of every person, reminding us that one day we will die, and nothing we have stored up on earth can be translated beyond the grave. The sober warning deserves our close consideration.” - Ligonier.org

Tuesday: Psalm 50

God is the Judge, and He will exercise righteous judgment. Pray and praise Him, knowing that when and how He judges is within His sovereign will. Ask the Lord for greater trust in Him and His righteousness.

Wednesday: Psalm 51

This psalm opens with an appeal to God for His forgiveness. The plea for mercy is a humble one, which is entirely based on His mercy that the worshipper recognizes they do not deserve. We do not deserve God’s mercy or His forgiveness for sin. Yet He is a merciful God who is faithful to forgive. As you confess your sin to the Lord, humbly ask for mercy and forgiveness.

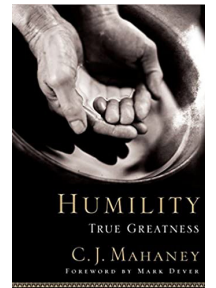
