

"Lovelace examines revivals (which are often called renewal movements) in the Bible and also throughout history. I believe that many theologically sound believers are suspect of spiritual renewal, and sometimes for good reason. There are two major reasons for this. First, people in the past have sought to manufacture revivals in unbiblical ways. Second, in all genuine revivals there can also be found



a group of false converts that get caught up in the excitement of it all. Neither of these are good reasons not to pray and long for true spiritual revival. True revival is a great and necessary thing!"
