

"Scripture commands us to meditate on God's wondrous works (Psalm 77:11-12). Thomas Watson wrote that meditation is 'a holy exercise of the mind whereby we bring the truths of God to remembrance, and do seriously ponder upon them and apply them to ourselves." - Randall Van Meggelen

## Friday: Psalm 78

This psalm begins with calling attention to and telling the "glorious deeds of the Lord, and his might" (v. 4) so "that the next generation might know them" (v. 6). The purpose is so that "they should not be like their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation" (v. 8). That generation was not faithful to God. We, too, are to tell the next generation about God. It should be our desire to tell the next generation of who God is, what He has done, and what it means to trust Christ.

## Saturday: Prayer

## Monday: Psalm 74

Verses 12-17 in today's passage recalls the mighty deeds God has done in the past. These deeds show how God has worked salvation, including the exodus from Egypt and the time in the wilderness. It is the God of the Bible who created, sustains, and saves. Take time to recall all that the Lord has done for you and praise Him for His faithfulness.

## **Tuesday: Psalm 75**

In today's passage, it is clear that God is the one who lifts and puts down. Those whom God "puts down" are those who are boastful and wicked. The faithful are to be patient and trust in the Lord's timing in these matters. Pray that you would place more trust in the Lord and His timing over putting down the wicked.

## Wednesday: Psalm 76

In Psalm 76 the "poet paints a picture of Israel's God as the one who acts decisively in power when needed (vv. 3-10) but also as the God who meets with his people and dwells with them (vv. 1-2). he is the one who brings peace (vv. 3, 8) and justice to the inflicted (v. 9) and who expands his community of blessings to all who acknowledge him, regardless of their starting point (v. 10)." – NIV Application Commentary


