

"Over and over throughout the Psalms, we are commanded to be the natural protectors under God of the weak, the poor, and the oppressed. Since they often have no one to defend them, we are to see that right is done for those who need an advocate." - Bonnie McKernan

Friday: Psalm 83

Thursday: Psalm 82

"Fill their faces with shame, that they may seek your name, O Lord" (v. 16). Here the psalmist is praying his enemies would know that the Lord is the One true God, and they would seek a relationship with Him. Our prayer should be that our enemies, ultimately God's enemies, would know who He is and desire to have a relationship with Him. Take time to pray that God's enemies would be saved.

Saturday: Prayer

Pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ in Nicaragua. Pray for healthy marriages, healthy families, and healthy churches.

Monday: Psalm 79

"Why pray if God already knows? One of the interesting dynamics of Psalm 79 is this whole idea of reminding God of things that have happened... We talk about things as we see them, and we let God shape us to see things from his perspective. We pray as an expression of love, not as a means to an end. That is why we pray even though God already knows." - The NIV Application Commentary

Tuesday: Psalm 80

"The Bible says in Psalm 80 and Isaiah 5 that Israel is the vine and that God is the vinedresser. When Jesus says 'I am the true vine' He is really saying, 'I am the true Israel.' He is saying that He is the embodiment of all that Israel should be. 'Should be' because, as is well known, Israel did not faithfully execute her mission as God's representative. Her sins and lack of repentance prevented her from being a faithful witness. But Jesus is not like that. He is the true Israel, and He faithfully executes all of God's purposes." - Ligonier.org

Wednesday: Psalm 81

In the first three verses of this psalm, there is a call to worship. This call is an exciting call where the people are called to "shout for joy" (v. 1) and a call to play various instruments (vv. 2-3). The rest of the psalm has a somber tone, but these verses remind the worshipper that hearing words from the Lord is a privilege that is worthy of singing and celebrating.


